

Name of Form:

Notice of General Election.

Section Reference:

Secs. 4.004, 83.010, 85.004, and 85.007, Texas Election Code.

Purpose:

To notify voters of time and date of November General Election and the location of polling places.

Number of Copies Required:

One per election precinct if notice is posted in each election precinct; one copy for each registered voter if mailed; one copy for a newspaper; and one copy for bulletin board.

Completed by:

County Judge.

Filing Date:

If posted in precinct, not later than 21 days before election; or if mailed to each registered voter, not later than the 10th day before election. The notice must be published not earlier than 30 days nor later than 10 days before the election.

Posted on bulletin board at least 21 days before election.

Filed with:

County Judge, one copy posted on bulletin board for posting notice of meetings of Commissioners Court.

Comments:

A copy of the notice shall be preserved for a period of 22 months after the election. The county judge shall also retain a copy of the published notice that contains the name of the newspaper and the date of publication.
