I am aware of the nepotism law, Chapter 573, Government Code.

I further swear that the foregoing statements included in my application are in all things true and correct."

INSTRUCTIONS

A declaration for write-in candidacy for County or precinct chair may not be filed earlier than 30 days before the filing deadline (i.e., November 29, 2011). The filing deadline is 6:00 p.m. of the 5th day after the date of the filing deadline for the primary election (i.e., December 19, 2011). (Section 171.0231, 172.054, Texas Election Code)

If the deadline for filing falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state holiday, the deadline is extended to the next regular business day.

The declaration shall be filed with the county chair or the secretary of the county executive committee, if there is one. Tex. Elec. Code Ann. § 172.022 (Vernon 1986).

¹All oaths, affidavits, or affirmations made within this State may be administered and a certificate of the fact given by a judge, clerk, or commissioner of any court of record, a notary public, a justice of the peace, city secretary, and the Secretary of State of Texas.

INSTRUCCIONES

Es prohibido presentar una declaración de candidatura como aspirante cuyo nombre deberá ser agregado por los votantes para el cargo de presidente de Condado o precinto electoral antes de 30 días inmediatamente previo a la fecha límite (es decir, 29 de noviembre del 2011). El último día es a las 6:00 de la tarde del 5° día después de la fecha límite normal para registrarse como candidato para la primaria (es decir 19 de diciembre del 2011). (Fracción 171.0231 del Código Electoral del Estado de Texas)

Si el último día para registrarse cae en un sábado, domingo, o un día feriado oficial estatal, se extiende la registración al siguiente día laborable.

La declaración se registrará con el presidente del condado o el secretario del comité ejecutivo del condado, si aplicable. Tex. Elec. Code Ann. § 172.022 (Vernon 2010).
