Comments:

Only one oath is necessary for each person who circulates petitions.

This petition is required for candidates running for office of chief justice or justice supreme court, or presiding judge or judge, court of criminal appeals.

Candidates must have 50 signatures from each of the 14 districts, which equals 700 total signatures.
