* If this Notice is to be used because election judges will be visiting a facility due to the early voting clerk deciding that ballots will be delivered to the facility even before the early voting clerk has received 5 or more applications for a ballot by mail that request the ballots be sent to the facility, then the notice must be posted no later than 48 hours before voting is to be conducted at the facility. The early voting clerk must provide the names of election judges, if known, when the notice is being posted for that purpose.

Instructions

1. If this notice is to be used because election judges will be visiting a facility due to the early voting clerk having received 5 or more applications for a ballot by mail that request the ballots be sent to the facility, then the notice must be posted no later than the 5th day before voting is to be conducted at the facility. The names of election judges need not be supplied when the notice is being posted for that purpose. Texas Election Code Section 107.007(c)
2. If this notice is to be used because election judges will be visiting a facility due to the early voting clerk deciding that ballots will be delivered to the facility even before the early voting clerk has received 5 or more applications for a ballot by mail that request the ballots be sent to the facility, then the notice must be posted no later than 48 hours before voting is to be conducted at the facility. The early voting clerk must provide the names of election judges, if known, when the notice is being posted for that purpose. Texas Election Code Section 107.007(f).
3. The early voting clerk must inform the residential care facility administrator, director, or other contact person when the notice must be posted.
4. This notice must be provided to the residential care facility administrator, director, or other contact person for the facility prior to the deadline for the notice to be posted.
5. The residential care facility administrator, director, or other contact person should post the notice in at least one common area where it will most likely be seen by the residents of the facility, on or before the deadline to post the notice.
