

Instructions

1. Residential Facility Judge (“RCF Judge”) prints voter’s name when voter is provided with balloting materials.
2. Voter signs to indicate receipt of balloting materials. If voter is unable to sign due to a physical disability, then the RCF Judge should place his or her initial in the appropriate column.
3. RCF Judge indicates whether the voter is:
 - A Pre-Applicant (“**P**”) - one who had submitted an application for a ballot by mail to the early voting clerk prior to the RCF Judges’ visit to the facility (these voters should be on the “List of Pre-Applicant Voters at Residential Care Facility,” form AW20-2, provided to the RCF Judges by the EV Clerk); or
 - An On-Site Applicant (“**O**”) – one who had not submitted an application for a ballot by mail to the early voting clerk prior to the RCF Judges’ visit to the facility, but rather is submitting an application for a ballot by mail to the RCF Judges while the RCF Judges are at the facility.
