## NOTES

1. A voter who applied for a ballot by mail to be delivered to a residential care facility (“RCF”) but who is not present on the day the election judges visit the RCF may complete and submit this request to have his or her ballot hand-delivered to the voter at the location at which the voter is temporarily located.
2. The election judges may deliver the balloting materials to the voter at the temporary location, but are not required to do so. If the election judges deliver the materials to the voter at the temporary location, the judges must deliver it directly to the voter and not to any agent, relative, or assistant outside of the voter’s presence. The judges may accept the completed ballot sealed inside the balloting envelopes back from the voter personally or may allow the voter to mail the ballot to the early voting clerk.
3. If the election judges do not deliver the materials to the voter at the temporary location, the judges shall instead deliver the materials back to the early voting clerk along with this request. The election judges must indicate below which action was taken.
4. If balloting materials are delivered back to the early voting clerk, the early voting clerk will mail the voter’s balloting materials to the temporary location or to the RCF, depending on when the voter indicates he or she will be returning to the RCF, and must indicate below to which address the balloting materials were mailed.
