Name of Form: Application for Ballot by Mail.

Form Number: 5-15.

Section Reference: Sections 84.001, 84.002, 84.011, and 86.0015 Texas Election Code.

Purpose: To allow early voting other than by personal appearance.

Number of Copies Required: One per early voter.

Completed by: Voter applying for ballot.

Filing Date: First day to apply is January 1 of any given year in which the applicant wishes to receive ballots. Last day in which an application may be received is the 11th day before the election unless the 11th day is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, in which case the last day is the first regular business day before the 11th day.

Filed with: Early Voting Clerk.

Comments:

Any application received that is not on this form is an "informal application" and may be accepted only if it contains the following information:

1. Name and residence address of registration of applicant.
2. Address to which ballot is to be mailed.
3. Indication of each election for which the voter is applying.
4. The ground of eligibility for voting by mail.
5. If the ground is absence from the county, an indication that the voter satisfies that ground (provides a mailing address outside the county of residence).
6. The signature of the applicant.
