Notice of Defective Application for Ballot by Mail.

Purpose:

Notify applicant of defective application.

Number of Copies Required:

Two recommended.

Early Voting Clerk.

Filing Date:

Immediately after determining defect.

Filed with:

Applicant. Copy of notice recommended to be attached to application for ballot.

Comments:

If the application for ballot by mail is received on or before the 12th day before the election, an official application for ballot by mail shall be included with the notice. If application is received after the 12th day and on or before the 4th day before the election, only the notice shall be mailed to the applicant.

If the applicant requests a runoff ballot on the same application, the timeliness of the application is determined in relation to the first election unless it is received too late for the first election. In this case, the application is rejected for the first election but is acceptable for the runoff if the voter is otherwise qualified.
