

Name of Form:

Request to Cancel Application for Ballot By Mail.

Section Reference:

Section 84.032, Texas Election Code.

Purpose:

To request Early Voting Clerk to void ballot by mail application.

Number of Copies Required:

One per voter voiding application.

Completed by:

Voter; officer administering oath.

Filing Date:

At any time between the filing of the application and the close of the polls on election day.

Filed with:

Early Voting Clerk or presiding Election Judge, as appropriate.

Comments:

The early voting clerk keeps this request for the same period as other election records. If the application is canceled, it is attached to the request.

The voter may use the same application at the polling place to cancel ballot by mail if the voter (i) has the ballot to turn in or (ii) presents a notice that voter has received under Section 86.006(h) Election Code, stating that the ballot was returned in violation of Section 86.006(h) and still not be counted; or use the appropriate oath on the provisional voting form if the voter does not have the ballot to turn in.
