Notice of Correction to Ballot by Mail.

Section Reference:

Section 86.009(b), Texas Election Code.

Purpose:

Notify voter of change of ballot.

Number of Copies Required:

One per voter.

Completed by:

Early Voting Clerk.

Filing Date:

Immediately upon receiving corrected balloting materials.

Filed with:

Voter who receives corrected materials.

Comments:

If the clerk determines that there is not sufficient time for the voter to receive and return the corrected ballot, the clerk shall not mail the corrected materials.

Clerk mails a new carrier envelope with corrected ballot with a notation on the carrier envelope "corrected ballot." The clerk also makes a notation on the application for mail ballot that the voter was sent a corrected ballot.
