**Comments:**

**In general elections for state and county officers, the county clerk/elections administrator must notify each county chair at least 24 hours of each delivery.**

**Mail ballots may not be delivered until after the early voting period ends, except as described by Section 87.0222.**

**Ballots may not be counted until polls open on election day, except as described by Section 87.0241.**
