**Name of Form:**

Curbside Voting Space (Button or Intercom)

**Section Reference:**

Sections 61.003, 64.009, 104.004, Texas Election Code

**Purpose:**

To alert voters, who may be unable to enter the polling place, that there is an option to vote at the curbside by pushing a button or using an intercom to request assistance from an election officer. To alert individuals that electioneering is prohibited within 20 feet of the curbside voting space.

**Number of Copies Required:**

One

**Completed by:**

An election officer at the polling place shall put the sign at the appropriate place, in the parking lot or drive, to notify voters that there is a designated space for curbside voting and that electioneering is prohibited.

**Filing Date:**

Before the polls open each morning of Early Voting and on Election Day morning before the polls open.

**Filed with:**

Post at the designated parking space before the polls open for voting.

**Comments:**

**Recommended Size**

It is recommended that the sign be no smaller than 12 x 18 inches.
