Christina and Charlie,

ECO-1190 is a modification to ES&S' EVS 6.2.0.0 and 6.3.0.0 systems that adds a plastic stopper piece to the DS950 central scanner. This additional component is designed to prevent a sensor arm on the output tray from becoming misaligned and incorrectly indicating that the bin is full.

I agree with Brian's assessment that this is a de minimis change that does not adversely impact the performance or security of the system. I recommend approval of the modification in ECO-1190.
