Comments:

The county clerk or election administrator may certify the unopposed status of a candidate for county or precinct office in the November general election and declare that candidate elected. The names of all county and precinct candidates declared elected shall appear separately on the ballot after the contested races under the heading "Unopposed Candidates Declared Elected." The candidates must be grouped in the same ballot order as they would have appeared for the ballot generally and their party affiliation or status as an independent must also be listed. No votes may be cast in connection with these candidates; therefore, the ballot may not allow for a vote to be cast for any or all of the candidates.
