

**Name of Form:**

Personal Notice of Recount

**Section Reference:**

Section 211.005, 212.032, 213.009, Texas Election Code

**Purpose:**

To provide notice to each person entitled by law to receive notice of recount. This notice is issued when a recount petition has been approved.

**Number of Copies Required:**

One per person to all persons entitled to receive notice of a recount pursuant to Section 212.032.

**Completed by:**

The Recount Supervisor and the Recount Coordinator. Please note that in some situations, the Recount Supervisor and Recount Coordinator may be the same person.

**Filing Date:**

Issued at least 18 hours before the recount begins except in the case of an early recount where all persons entitled to notice agree to begin earlier than 18 hours.

**Filed With One of the Following:**

- **A Recount That Involves Nomination or Election to an Office:** Each opposing candidate;
- **A Recount That Involves an Election for Presidential Electors:** If the recount involves an election for presidential electors, the presidential candidate who is shown by the election returns to have received the most votes;
- **A Recount That Involves a Measure:** The campaign treasurer of each specific-purpose political committee involved in the election on the side opposite the side that the petitioner represents; or a person eligible to vote in the election, selected by the recount coordinator as an appropriate representative of the interests of the opposite side, if no specific-purpose committee was involved in the election; **OR**
- **A Recount That Involves a Presidential Primary Election:** Each opposing candidate; and a registered voter selected by the Recount Coordinator as an appropriate representative of the interests of the uncommitted delegation, if an uncommitted delegation is entitled to delegate representation.

**Comments:**

Form 14-9 can function as both the Notice of Recount and the record of notice of recount. By keeping a copy of the notice sent to each person entitled to receive notice of a recount, the records retention requirement is met. [Sec. 211.005(b)]
