Number of Copies Required:

One per candidate

Completed by:

Registered voter signing the petition, person circulating petition, and person administering the oath.

Filing Date:

A Declaration of Write-In Candidacy must be filed not later than 5:00 p.m. of the 78th day before the general election and it may not be filed earlier than the 30th day before the filing deadline.

Filed with:

Secretary of State for state and district offices and the County Judge for county and precinct offices.

Comments:

Persons who sign the petition must be qualified voters of the state or district as appropriate. A voter may only sign one petition for a candidate in the same race.
