The Declaration of Write-In Candidacy shall be filed with the Secretary of State for statewide and district offices or with the county judge for county and precinct offices. Texas Election Code, Section 146.024

This candidate application must be accompanied by either a filing fee or a completed Petition in Lieu of a Filing Fee. The filing fee or the Petition in Lieu of a Filing Fee must be presented at the time the application is filed. Sections 146.0232, 172.025, Texas Election Code. For additional information, please see the Candidate's Guide on the Secretary of State's website, including the page on Frequently Asked Questions on Party Affiliation and Candidacy.

## **FILING PERIOD**

The Declaration of Write-In Candidacy must be filed not later than 5:00 p.m. of the 78th day before general election day and not earlier than 30 days before the filing deadline. Texas Election Code, Section 146.025(a).

The filing deadline is extended if a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot dies or is declared ineligible after the third day preceding the filing deadline. The extended filing deadline is 5:00 p.m. of the 75th day preceding Election Day. Texas Election Code, Section 146.025(b).

<sup>1</sup>An application for a place on the ballot, including any accompanying petition, is public information immediately on its filing. (Section 141.035, Texas Election Code)

<sup>2</sup>Inclusion of a candidate's VUID is optional. However, many candidates are required to be registered voters in the territory from which the office is elected at the time of the filing deadline. Please visit the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's website for additional information.

<sup>3</sup>All oaths, affidavits, or affirmations made within this State may be administered and a certificate of the fact given by a judge, clerk, or commissioner of any court of record, a notary public, a justice of the peace, and the Secretary of State of Texas. See Chapter 602 of the Texas Government Code for the complete list of persons authorized to administer oaths.
