**To put Secretary of State on notice of defectively-printed ballots.**

**Not later than 24 hours after the authority decides to reprint the ballots.**

**Comments:**

**The name, address, and telephone number of the printer/vendor who reprints or reprograms the ballots is only necessary in the primary and general elections for state and county offices.**

**If the ballots will be corrected by use of stickers or pasters or by darkening out obscure language, the notice is not required to be filed with the Secretary of State.**

**Failure to deliver this notice within the time period is a Class A misdemeanor.**

**If the authority responsible determines to print new ballots, the new ballots must be numbered beginning with number 1 and numbered consecutively.**
