To put public on notice of the destruction of the ballots.

At least 72 hours before destruction.

Filed with:

Posted continuously in the authority's office.

Comments:

The Sheriff of the County must be present when the defectively-printed ballots are destroyed for the primary, runoff, general election for state and county officers, and any other election ordered by the Governor. In all other elections, the authority ordering the election must be present when the defectively printed ballots are destroyed.

If the entire governing body is required to order the election, a quorum of the body is required to be present at the time of the destruction of the ballots.
