## INSTRUCTIONS

A candidate (including a certified write-in candidate) whose name appeared on the ballot (or on the list of Declared Write-in Candidates) may appoint one representative for a Partial Manual Count. There are no other appointing authorities authorized to appoint a representative for a Partial Manual Count, other than candidates.

The representative appointed to serve at a Partial Manual Count, must deliver a Certificate of Appointment to the General Custodian of Election Records at the time the representative reports for service. The Certificate of Appointment must be in writing and include the following:

- (1) the printed name and signature of the representative;
- (2) the election subject to the count; and
- (3) the printed name and signature of the candidate making the appointment.

If the representative is not accepted for service, the certificate shall be returned to the representative with a signed statement of the reason for the rejection.

On accepting a representative for a Partial Manual Count for service, the General Custodian shall provide the representative with a form of identification, prescribed by the Secretary of State, to be displayed by the representative during the representative's hours of service.
