Notice of Ballot Correction.

Section Reference:

Section 52.0061, Texas Election Code.

Purpose:

To put Secretary of State on notice of defectively-printed ballots.

Number of Copies Required:

One.

Completed by:

Authority responsible for ordering ballots.

Filing Date:

Not later than 24 hours after the authority decides to reprint the ballots.

Filed with:

Secretary of State.

Comments:

The name, address, and telephone number of the printer who reprints the ballots is only necessary in the primary and general elections for state and county offices.

If the ballots will be corrected by use of stickers or by darkening out obscure language, the notice is not required to be filed with the Secretary of State.

Failure to deliver this notice within the time period is a Class A misdemeanor.

If the authority responsible determines to print new ballots, the new ballots must be numbered beginning with number 1 and numbered consecutively.
