RE: SSL CERTIFICATE UPDATES APPROVAL REQUEST

Dear Keith:

Dominion Voting Systems, Inc. (Dominion) wants to provide, to its customers in the State of Texas, new versions of GEMS 1.18.24 and BallotStation 4.6.4 that contain updated SSL client and root certificates. As you are aware, the SSL client certificates in the current GEMS 1.18.24 and BallotStation 4.6.4 installations will expire on July 3, 2013 at which time those customer jurisdictions will not be able to upload or download data between GEMS and their touch screen products (AccuVote-TSX and AccuVote-TS R6). The new versions (GEMS 1.18.24D and BallotStation 4.6.4D) have updated SSL certificates that don't expire until July 12, 2027. Trusted builds of these versions were created by SLI Global Solutions (SLI Global), an EAC accredited Voting System Test Laboratory (VSTL). Please see the SLI Global Test Report (attached) for details on the trusted build process. Also attached are Dominion's installation instructions. In a courier shipment, there will be hardcopies of these documents and a CD containing the install files.

Before Dominion can provide these new GEMS and BallotStation versions to our customers in Texas, we must first receive written approval from the State Election Authority that these new versions can be used in the state. If your office determines that these new GEMS and BallotStation versions are acceptable for use, please provide your decision in a written response (email, fax and/or regular mail) directed to my attention.
