Texas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board

Title 22, Part 8

The Texas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board (TALCB) files this notice of intention to review 22 TAC Chapter 159, Rules Relating to the Provisions of the Texas Appraisal Management Company Registration and Regulation Act. This review is undertaken pursuant to Government Code, §2001.039.

During the review process, TALCB may determine whether a specific rule requires amendments to refine TALCB's legal and policy considerations; whether the rules reflect current TALCB procedures; that no changes to a rule as currently in effect are necessary; or that a rule is no longer valid or applicable. Rules may also be combined or reduced for simplification and clarity when feasible. Readopted rules will be noted in the *Texas Register*'s Rules Review section without publication of the text. Any proposed amendments or repeal of a rule or chapter as a result of the review will be published in the Proposed Rules section of the *Texas Register* and will be open for an additional 30-day public comment period before final adoption or repeal.

TALCB will accept comments for 30 days following publication of this notice in the *Texas Register* as to whether the reasons for adopting the sections under review continue to exist. Final consideration of this rules review is expected at the TALCB meeting in November 2018.

Title 19, Part 2

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) proposes the review of 19 TAC Chapter 61, School Districts, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, §2001.039. The rules being reviewed by the TEA in 19 TAC Chapter 61 are organized under the following subchapters: Subchapter AA,

Texas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board

Title 22, Part 8

In accordance with Texas Government Code §2001.039, the Texas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board (TALCB) has concluded its review of 22 TAC Chapter 157, Rules Relating to Practice and Procedure. The notice of proposed rule review was published in the December 22, 2017, issue of the *Texas Register* (42 TexReg 7413).

TALCB has determined that the reasoned justification for adopting 22 TAC 157 continues to exist. Furthermore, the review process may indi-

cate that a specific rule needs to be amended to further refine or better reflect current TALCB procedures and policy considerations, or that rules be combined or reduced for simplification and clarity. Accordingly, TALCB adopts with amendments 22 TAC 157, Subchapters A, B, C, D, and E (proposed in the February 23, 2018, issue of the *Texas Register* - 43 TexReg 997) and adopted under the Adopted Rules section of this issue of the *Texas Register*.
