## Proposed Rule Reviews

Texas Education Agency

### Title 19, Part 2

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) proposes the review of 19 TAC Chapter 149, Commissioner's Rules Concerning Educator Standards, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, §2001.039. The rules being reviewed by the TEA in 19 TAC Chapter 149 are organized under the following subchapters: Subchapter AA, Teacher Standards; and Subchapter BB, Administrator Standards.

As required by the Texas Government Code, §2001.039, the TEA will accept comments as to whether the reasons for adopting 19 TAC Chapter 149, Subchapters AA and BB, continue to exist.

The public comment period on the review of 19 TAC Chapter 149, Subchapters AA and BB, begins August 3, 2018, and ends September 4, 2018. ### Title 37, Part 5

Under the 1997 General Appropriations Act, Article IX, Section 167, Review of Agency Rules, the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles files this notice of intent to review and consider for readoption, revision, or repeal, Texas Administrative Code, Title 37, Public Safety and Corrections, Part 5, Chapter 145 (Parole).

The Board undertakes its review pursuant to Government Code, §2001.039. The Board will accept comments for 30 days following the publication of this notice in the *Texas Register* and will assess whether the reasons for adopting the sections under review continue to exist. Proposed changes to the rule as a result of the rule review will be published in the Proposed Rules section of the *Texas Register*. The proposed rules will be open for public comment prior to final

adoption by the Board, in accordance with the requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act, Government Code, Chapter 2001.

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## Adopted Rule Reviews

Commission on State Emergency Communications

### Title 1, Part 12

The Commission on State Emergency Communications (CSEC) has concluded the statutory review of its Chapter 251 rules. Based on its review, CSEC readopts without amendment §§251.2, 251.4, 251.5, 251.8, and 251.10 - 251.16. In the Proposed Rules section of this issue of the *Texas Register*, CSEC proposes for comment amendments to §251.1, relating to regional strategic plans for 9-1-1 service; §251.3, relating to use of revenue in certain counties; and §251.7, relating to guidelines for implementing integrated services.

CSEC's notice of intent to review its Chapter 251 rules was published in the March 16, 2018, issue of the *Texas Register* (43 TexReg 1677). The review assessed whether the reasons for originally adopting the rules continue to exist. CSEC reviewed each rule in Chapter 251 and determined that for those rules being readopted without amendment the original reasoned justification for the rules continues to exist and the rules are within the agency's legal authority as certified by legal counsel. For those rules being proposed with amendments, CSEC has provided with each its reasoned justification and certification of legal authority.

No comments were received regarding CSEC's notice of review. This notice concludes CSEC's review of its Chapter 251 rules.
