## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR INDEPENDENT CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT**

The application must be accompanied by written statements signed by each presidential elector giving their written consent to be an elector for the presidential candidate (total of 40 electors). The application must also be submitted with a petition signed by the required number of registered voters who did not vote in a presidential primary.

The application, together with the written statements and petition, must be filed with the Secretary of State no later than the second Monday in May of the presidential election year.

<sup>1</sup> All oaths, affidavits, or affirmations made within this State may be administered and a certificate of the fact given by a judge, clerk, or commissioner of any court of record, a notary public, a justice of the peace, and the Secretary of State of Texas.
